

Pursuant to the Article 16 of the Ordinance on the Organisation and Management of the National Top-level Domain (Official Gazette no. 38/2010 and 81/2015), the Managing Council of CARNet, as proposed by the .hr Domain Management Committee on the session held on April 20th 2016 has brought the following

DECISION ON THE PROCEDURE AND CONDITIONS FOR CHANGING THE USER OF .HR DOMAIN

Changes of the user of additional (payable) domains is to be considered as the change of the user's name and other relevant user data.

The request for change of the domain user is to be submitted by the existing domain user. New user must confirm that he agrees with the change, i.e. that he becomes the user of the subject domain which confirms that he is in agreement with all provisions of the Ordinance and acquires all the rights and obligations towards CARNet and third parties in accordance to the Ordinance.

Both, existing and the new user must unambiguously identify themselves when submitting, i.e. accepting the request.

The procedure of changing the user is to be carried out by the means of authorised registrars stated in the Registry of .hr domains.

The change of the user shall be payable in favour of the registrar in accordance to the Price List published at the website <http://dns.hr>. The price of changing the users is determined by the registrar itself.

By way of derogation from the paragraph 5 of this Decisions and in case of the legal succession the fee shall not be charged.

This Decision is valid on the date of September 1st 2016.
