

**CONDITIONS AND CRITERIA**  
**for legal and natural persons who wish to conclude an Agreement for the**  
**purpose of performing domain registration activities within the scope of**  
**CARNET**

Pursuant to Article 26. of the Ordinance on the Organization and Management of the Top-level National Internet Domain (OG 83/2023, hereinafter: the Ordinance), the CARNET Managing Council determined the following conditions for legal entities and natural persons to whom CARNET contractually transfers certain domain registration tasks from its scope (hereinafter: Registrars).

1. The registrar can be:
  - a legal person having its registered office in the European Union or
  - a natural person with an independent activity who has a registered office in the European Union and who has a personal identification number (OIB) issued by the competent authority of the Republic of Croatia.
2. The Registrar must have its own domain under the top-level (.hr) domain and an active website on which it must advertise the registration of .hr domains. The Registrar is obliged to communicate the URL of that page to CARNET in advance. CARNET has the right to place on its pages an active link to the pages of the Registrar;
3. Prior to the conclusion of the Agreement, the Registrar is obliged to submit to CARNET a Statement of Compliance according to the template published on the CARNET website.
4. Before concluding an Agreement with CARNET the Registrar is obliged to provide contact information according to the template published on the CARNET web site.
5. Before concluding an Agreement with CARNET, the Registrar is obliged to prove the technical knowledge and ability to work with the application solution of CARNET's domain registration system and/or Electronic Application System (EPP) service through the test execution of at least five different transactions in all categories in the test system.
6. When concluding an Agreement with CARNET on the transfer of domain registration activities, the Registrar is obliged to pay CARNET an initial one-off fee in the amount of EUR 530.89;
7. The Registrar guarantees the payment of its obligations with a bank guarantee in the minimum amount of EUR 1,327.23. The maximum amount of the bank guarantee is set by the Registrar. Instead of submitting a bank guarantee, the Registrar has the possibility to make a cash deposit in the required amount or in a larger amount in accordance with the rules applicable to the bank guarantee;
8. The Registrar must have visible links on its web site of the Ordinance and other relevant documents specified by CARNET. The Registrar must have visible domain Price list as well as all obligations to inform online marketplace providers, in accordance with the Consumer Protection Act (OG 19/2022, 59/2023);
9. The Registrar is obliged to submit a certified translation of all necessary documentation in Croatian;
10. CARNET and the Registrar will conclude an Agreement that will further regulate the rights and obligations from the domain registration activities within the scope of CARNET.
